## **GUIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF TEXTILE UPHOLSTERY**

### **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CLEANING OUR “PROTEC” FABRICS.**

For treating stains on these qualities, it is recommended the use of cleaning products that have been specifically developed for Pytón and that we are proposing you in our website. Anyway, there are some tips on how to treat them in general:


- To avoid that stain draws into the fabric, remove it immediately.
- Do not briskly rub the stain. Wipe off any excess with some cloth and with blotting or dabbing motion, work from the edge of the stain inwards to prevent it spreading.
- For stains without viscosity (like coffee or red wine) it is advised to previously absorb the stain with some cellulose paper to improve the final cleaning result.
- Do never try to rub generic home detergent into the stain (like oily substances or solvents with chemical or acid compounds since they could alter the inherent quality of the fabric itself).
- Kindly use cleaning products that have been recommended for that use but, if not available, use a soft damp cloth moistened with mild pH neutral soap.
- Dry cleaning is not recommended since it may reduce the external protection treatment.
- Regular cleaning and maintenance (passing a vacuum cleaner or cloth over the surface frequently) prevents dirt or dust from attaching itself to the fabric and ensures optimum performance of your upholstery.
- In case of organic stains, please follow recommendations above and proceed with mechanical washing according to specifications mentioned at the bottom of the page.

May we draw your attention to any responsibility exemption from stains provoked by pen, jeans or other fabrics not duly fixed in their dyeing process that may rub off onto the upholstery fabric.


Perspiration effects should be also highlighted since it is consisted of sour agents that may affect the structure of the fabric. The wear-out effect can be minimized if, before it soaks, you clean it with water and pH neutral soap damp cloth.

Then, wipe off leftovers with lukewarm water and dry preferably with hairdryer or vacuum cleaner, or failing them, rub dry with soft cloth.


The procedure may need to be repeated.







## **Tips for maintaining your sofa.**

### **Professional cleaning and care for your home.**

This cleaning set that we are introducing you has been specially conceived and developed for the proper care of your upholstery in:

#### **MICROFIBRE TEXTILE**

(with PU, TEFLON or waterproof protection)

At Pytón we know about the concern of providing a healthy environment at home and therefore we are bent on contributing solutions that investigation and technology are helping us to submit.

In this context, kindly allow us to suggest you the better way to get the best results in their cleaning.

- Brush dust daily, with a soft-haired brush.
- Treat stains immediately, specially those provoked by dyestuff that has not been fixed correctly like jeanswear, by spilling, sweat, etc. so that they do not soak and draw into the fabric.
- Do not place the piece of furniture near extreme heat or cold sources.
- Do try that halogen lamps (warm light) do not focus directly over the upholstered unit.
- Do never use everyday domestic care products and specially avoid: window cleaners, dry foam that has not been specified for Polyester or other chemical compounds that have not been recommended and that may seriously affect your upholstery.

These guidelines, along with right handling in accordance with our advice on our care record, will enable you to long-term enjoying the comfort and quality of what we hope it is a special piece at your home.



## **THE CLEANING SET FOR FABRICS WITH PROTECTION IS MADE UP OF:**

- Contents:

- Cleanser 1 250 ml
- Stain-remover 1 250 ml
- Microfibre cloth 2 (green and yellow)

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE**

On the base that impurities are wiped off daily with some soft-haired brush, this proceeding shall be enhanced by using the *soap cleanser* of the set weekly.

First you should shake the cleanser bottle and then spray gently the zone to be treated, at a distance of about 20 cm.

Let repose a few seconds to let the solution work on the fabric, then dry it with the green cloth provided by the set for that use. In case of suede fabrics (with hair), it is recommended to brush the fabric hair-wise and smoothly.

In the event of organic stains (tomato, soft drinks, sauces, etc.) it is important to treat them immediately in order to avoid them soak the fibres.

Remove excess fluid with some clean cloth; apply the *stain remover* following these steps below:

- Shake the stain remover bottle, spray gently on the stain, at about 10 cm, and allow it to work for one minute. Then wipe with the yellow cloth to dry and remove excess.

- *The procedure may need to be repeated. Brush treated surface smoothly.*

It is recommended, after treating fabric with the stain remover, to apply the cleanser of the cleaning set, following the steps above, in order to regenerate the fabric compound.

**Remark:** We should advice the user that stains provoked by pen, sweat or discolouring are, depending on their intensity, rather difficult to treat without affecting the structure of the fabric so that we cannot guarantee their complete removal with the organic compounds with which this cleaning set is formulated, specifically studied in order not to alter the fibres concerned.
